1	Minutes	Minutes of 24 April 2008 were accepted..
2	Treasurer's Report	Steve Zink prepared a written report; it is available from Steve or from the club secretary.
3	Membership and Administrative items	Ken Sale volunteered to be the membership coordinator, succeeding Judith Stevenson. There were glitches in the creation of the membership roster; the club agreed to correct this by sending out an errata sheet in addition to a PDF version of the entire updated directed. Randy announced ordering badges. He also noted the availability of club T-shirts. The club confirmed that the costs of tank-tops is \$10.
4	IAGSDC conventions	It was agreed to request the 2008 Convention Committee in Cleveland to allow all three San Francisco clubs to be together in the Grand March. It was announced that the reps of the Bay Area clubs met to discuss the 2013 convention and agreed on proposing that the 2013 convention be in SF Area (likely to be the July 4 weekend, which is Thursday-Sunday..
5	Summer Schedule	The club agreed to the following schedule for the summer: Sundays: Advanced on each Sunday we dance 4-6p; C1/C2 on alternating 2-4p. [20 July: C1,A; 3Aug: C2,A; 24 Aug:C1,A; 7 Sept: C2,A.] Wednesdays: Alternate A/C1 and C2/C3a on the Wednesdays that we have the space.
6.	Fall Classes	There was thoughtful discussion on the pedagogical needs for effective teaching. Allan and Ed will send out a survey to learn the levels of classes desired. The survey will go to MS and other clubs. At the next meeting the club will decide on the fall teaching schedule and club dancing schedules.
7	Push Open the Golden Gate	Michael Levy gave a report with much good news. 102 registrations are already in-hand, and achieved 2/3 of the required budget. He noted that there is a surprising number of dancers at the levels C3a, C3b and C4.

10	New Business	Steve Zink introduced a proposal to allow for free membership for financial hardship.
